

**THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS BY-LAW 8/2020**

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS TO PRESCRIBE FEES, FINES, AND CHARGES FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES**

**WHEREAS** Section 232(2)(d) of The Municipal Act, a municipality may be in a By-law establish fees or other charges for services, activities or things provided or done by the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of Reynolds deems it advisable to include in one By-law the fees and charges payable to the Rural Municipality for certain services rendered by officers and employees of the Rural Municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the Rural Municipality of Reynolds deems it necessary and expedient to keep current the schedule of fees for the services provided by the Rural Municipality of Reynolds;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Reynolds, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** this By-law shall be known as **The Fees, Fines and Charges By-law**.

2. **THAT** the fees and charges payable to the Rural Municipality of Reynolds for services rendered by officers and employees of the Municipality shall be as set out in the following schedules attached hereto and replace any other fees charged in any Rural Municipality of Reynolds By-laws:

<b>Schedule "A"</b>	<b>Finance and Administration</b>
<b>Schedule "B"</b>	<b>Animal Control</b>
<b>Schedule "C"</b>	<b>Building/Planning/Zoning/Property</b>

3. **THAT** the fees, fines and charges set out in the schedules attached to this By-law shall take precedence over any other previous related By-law


4. **THAT** any unpaid fees or charges owing to the Municipality that relate to property, including any penalties related thereto and any fines imposed on the taxpayer, may be added to the taxpayer's taxes and may be collected by the Municipality in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under The Municipal Act.

5. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect on March 11, 2021.

6. **THAT** By-Law 08/20 "Schedule C" shall hereby be an amendment to By-Laws 06/93, 06/04 and 02/10.

Animal Running at Large (dog, cat & livestock)	\$75	\$300
Allow animal to attack, chase, harass or threaten a person or animal	\$500	\$1000
Leave an animal improperly unattended while tethered in a public place or leave an animal unattended in a vehicle for such length of time as to endanger its life	\$50	\$75
Permit their animal to disturb or annoy the quiet of others by insistent howling, barking or other loud noise(s)	\$50	\$75
Cause of injury or death to a person or domestic animal	\$150	\$1000
Failure to remove dog and cat feces from private or public property	\$150	\$250
Allow premises to become offensive or affect the health and comfort of other persons by reason of filthy conditions, offensive odors	\$150	\$250
Permit domestic animal to damage public or private property other than that of its owner	\$150	\$250
Lack of securely controlling an un-spayed female dog or cat while in heat	\$100	\$500
